2009 Interfaith Prayer Vigil

In anticipation of the release of the 2009 Provincial Budget we pray for the Members of Provincial Parliament (MPPs) and for those who are most economically marginalized: people who are low wage workers, disabled, on social assistance, children, and/or homeless.

Specific MPPs will be remembered each day; prayers will be for their integrity, courage, and spiritual sustenance. Those who suffer unnecessarily in our wealthy province will also be remembered. Finally the prayers will reflect: "How can each of us be in solidarity with those who make decisions and those who suffer?"

The Interfaith Prayer Vigil will run in March - Monday through Thursday. A morning shift will run from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. and an afternoon shift from 12:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. Morning and afternoon shifts overlap for one hour. At noon, a religious leader will lead participants in prayer and reflection.

Notes for Participating Groups or Individuals

- Bring your own snacks, lunch and beverages, as ISARC will only be able to provide limited refreshments.
- Please dress warmly if it is cold.
- Parking on the grounds is not permitted. You are encouraged to access the Legislative grounds via public transit.
- Washroom facilities in the Legislative Building may be available to participants in small groups.
- The Legislative Security Service is the sole security provider for the Legislative Grounds and must be notified of any incidents on the grounds including any medical emergencies.
- Information and literature related to the event shall not be actively distributed but may be made available for pickup by the general public if requested.
- Access to the Legislative grounds shall not be impeded or obstructed in any way.
